# Why is the SMART choice?

---

- Northwest ISD transportation currently uses Zonar, which is quickly becoming outdated and more costly to upgrade than changing to an improved program. Numerous inaccuracies have been occurring regarding the parent app causing parent concerns when they are not able to track their student's location to and from school along with other issues we work through daily.
- Below are a few of the key functions that will better serve our community and school district.
  - SMART Tag has advanced to become one of the industry leading bus ridership programs.
  - Utilizing RFID cards for accurate ridership ensures students are getting off at the correct stops along with being placed on the correct bus, which is important for all students but even more important for elementary students.
  - Safer for drivers by offering turn-by-turn directions versus the paper route sheets we currently use. SMART Tag seamlessly works with our current routing software, which removes the need to change that program as well.
  - Real-time parent communication regarding delays and any other communication we need to push out to parents.

# Student ID Cards

SMART tag™ student ID cards are printed with a barcode that is the student's ID number making the card multi-purpose to be used in the library and cafeteria.

# Seating Charts

Electronic seating charts are customized to each route tier making it easy to know where students have assigned seats for contact tracing.

Seating charts are configured to match the seats in all different bus types.

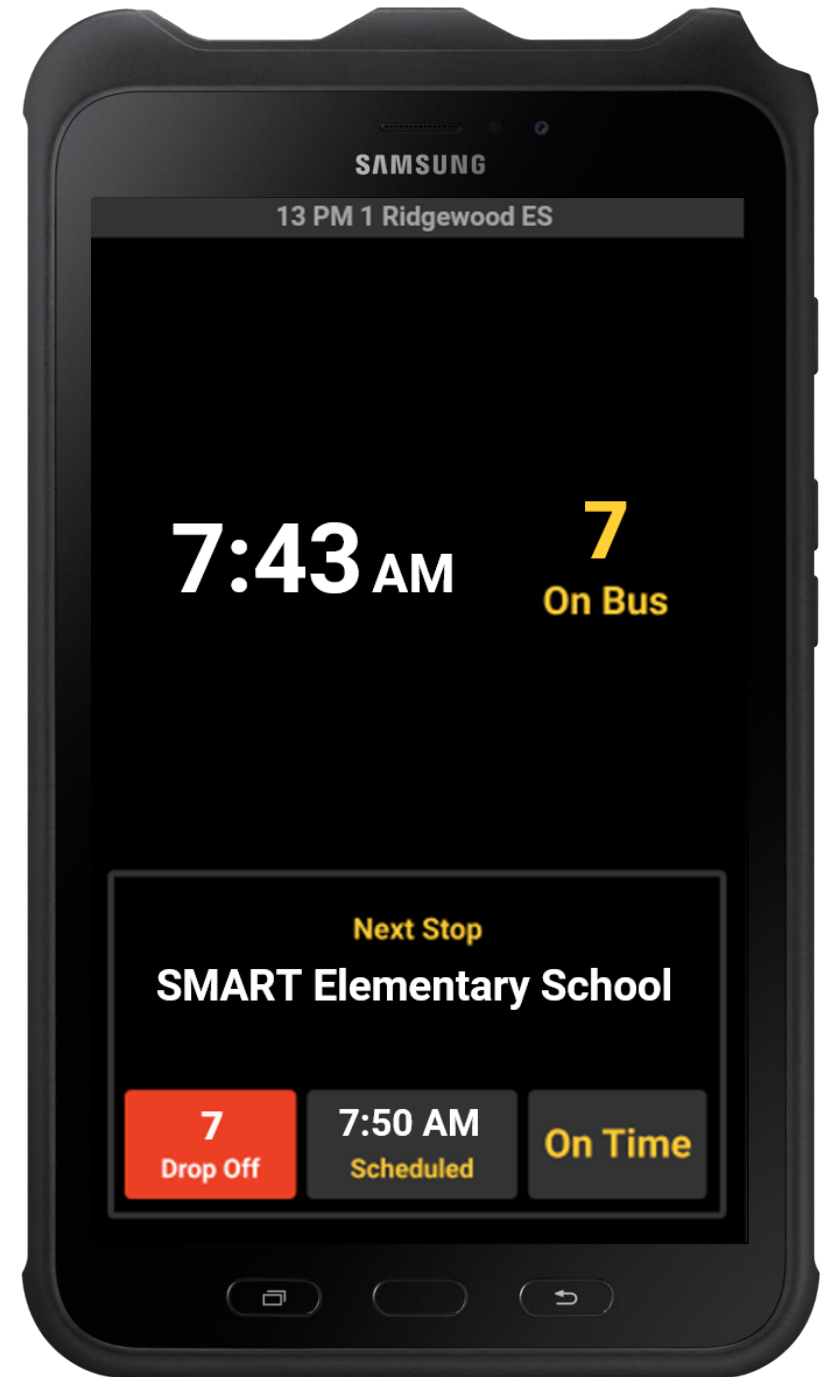




# Drive Mode

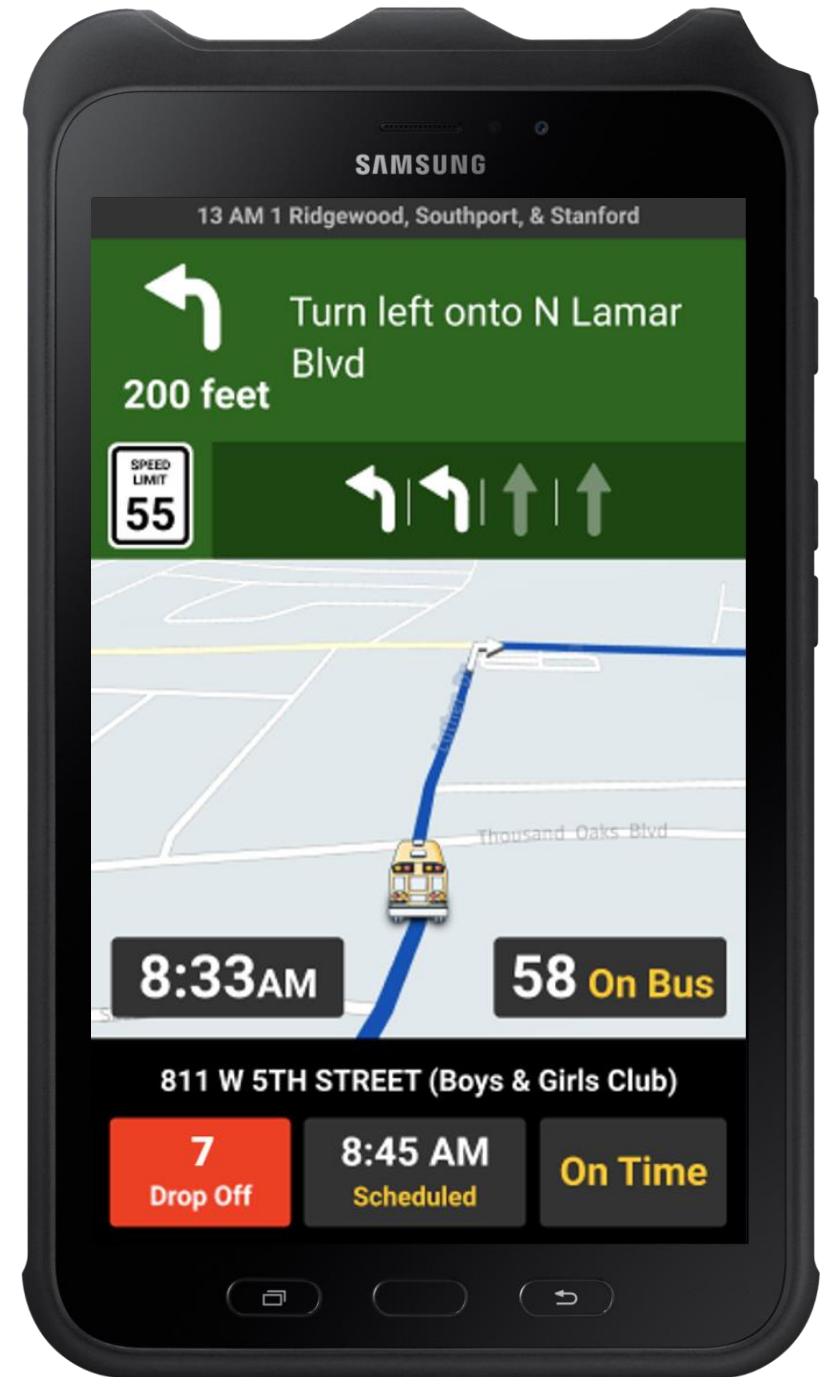
For safety, when the bus is moving the screen becomes non-interactive but displays important information for drivers.

SMART tag™ also displays how many students on the bus need to get off at the next Drop Off stop so drivers don't need to ask.



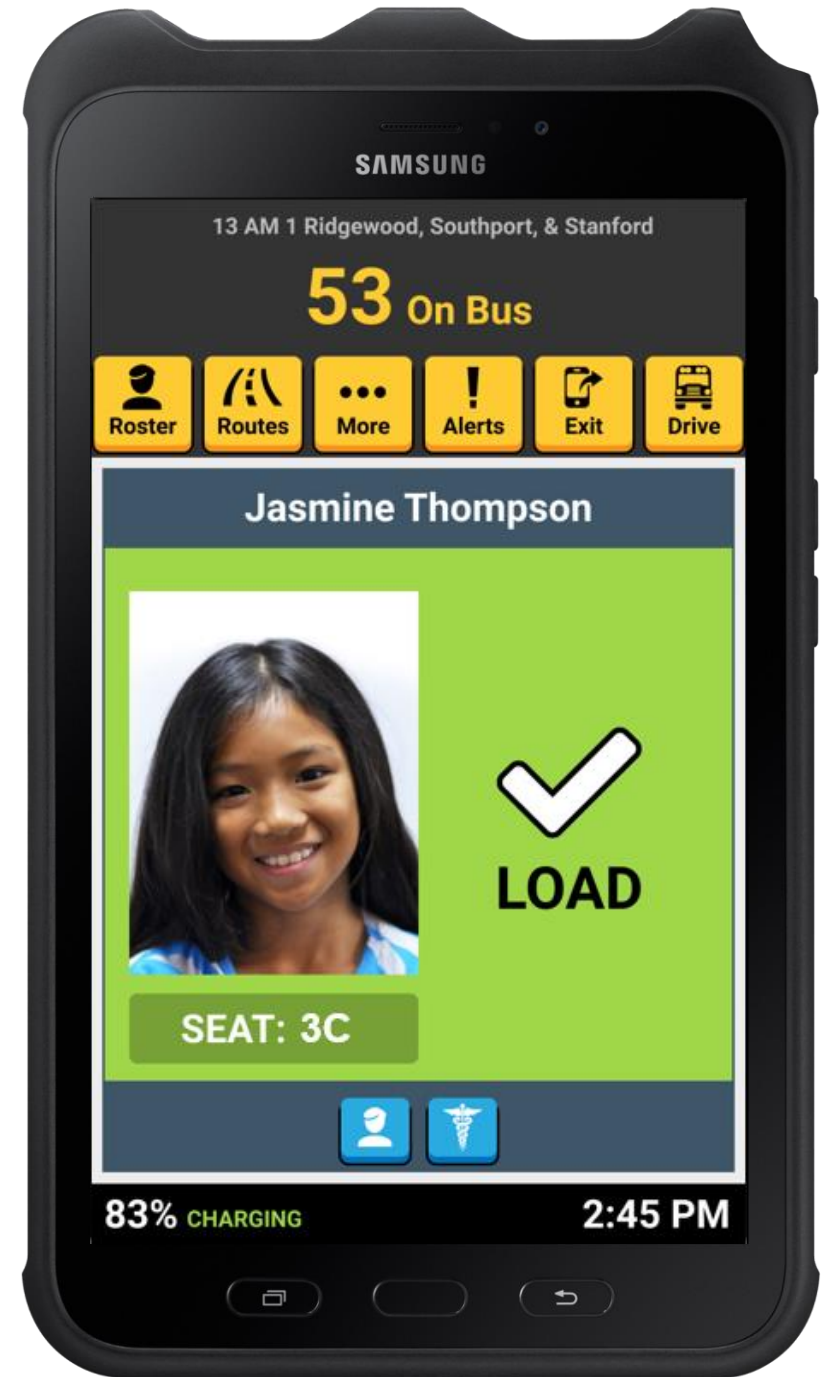
# Turn-By-Turn Navigation

Turn-by-turn navigation is configurable so it can be displayed with written directions only, or you can also activate the map.



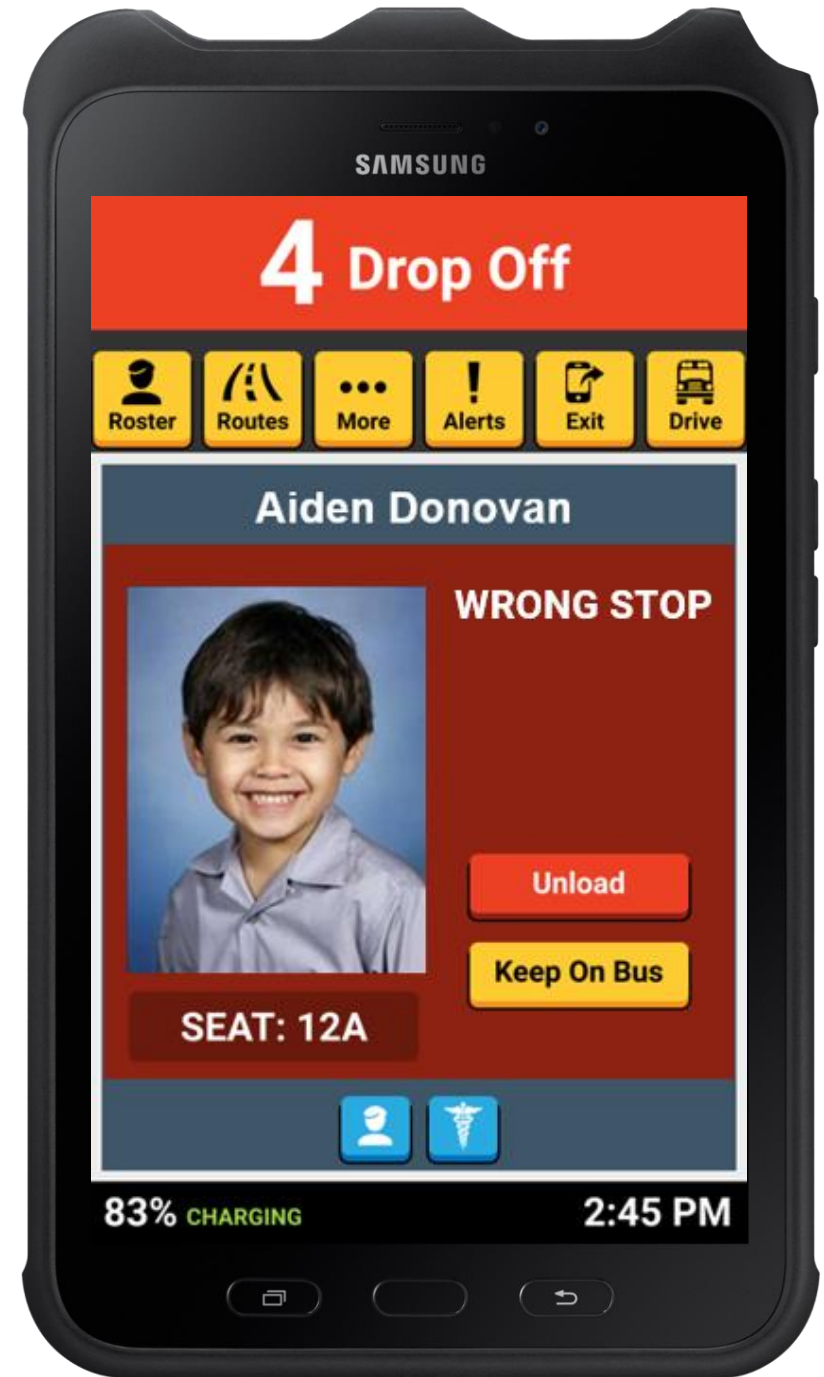
# Authorized Loading/Unloading

SMART tag™ informs drivers when students are authorized to load onto their bus and when students are authorized to get off at their assigned stop with visual and audio cues.



# Unauthorized Loading/Unloading

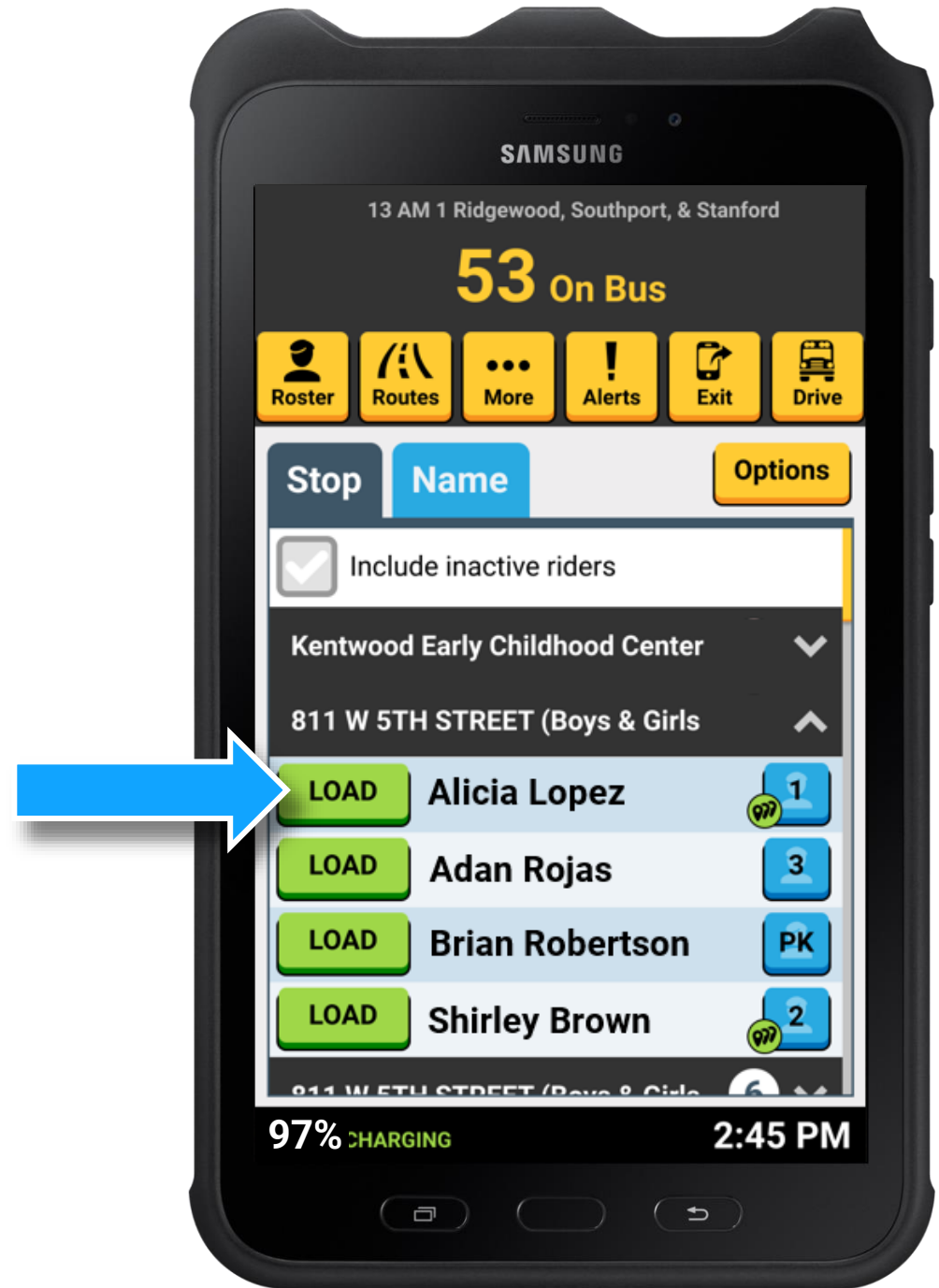
When students attempt to get on the wrong bus or get off at the wrong stop, SMART tag™ alerts the driver to prevent that from happening.





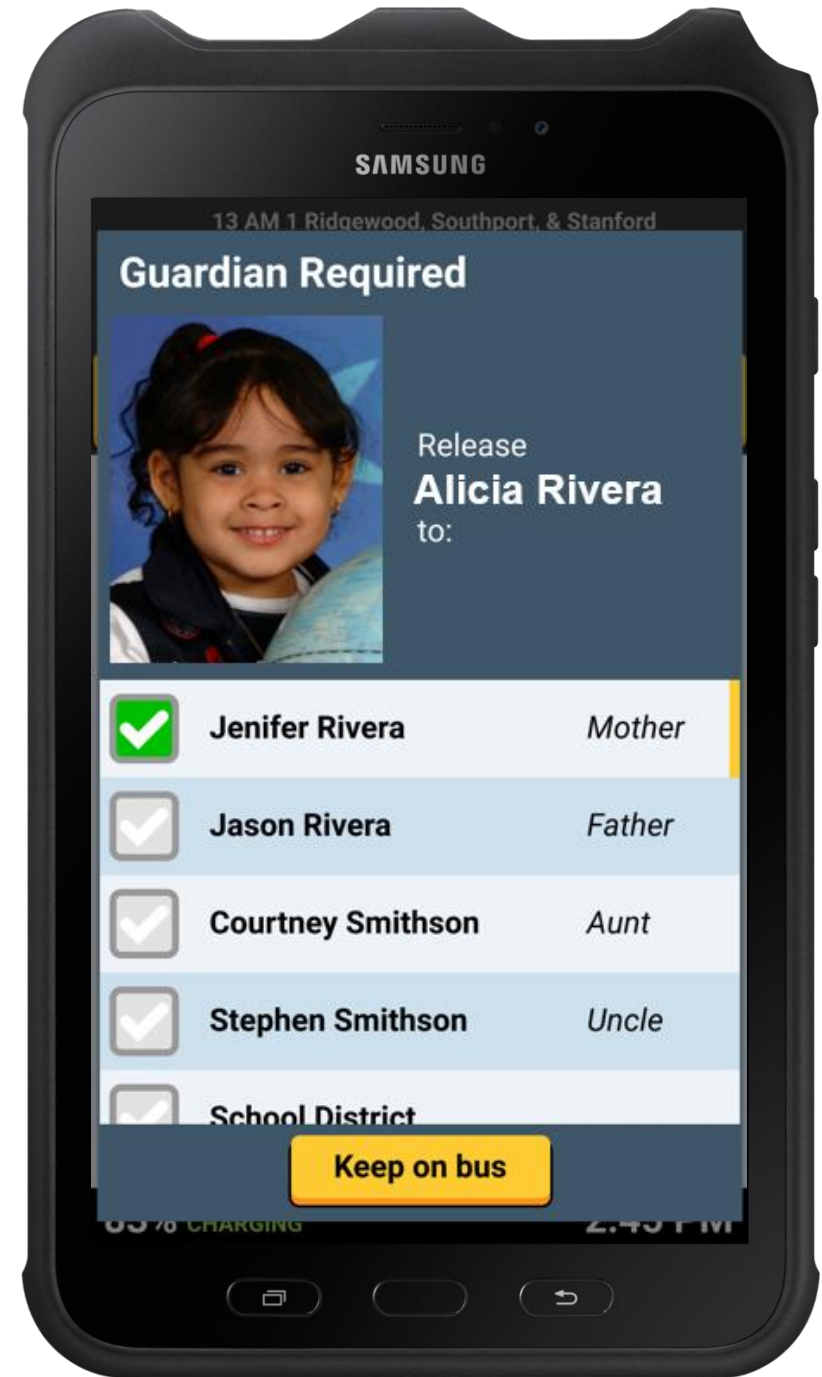
# Manual Loading/Unloading

If a student forgets or loses their SMART tag™ ID, the driver simply taps the load or unload button next to the student's name.



# Guardian Required

SMART tag™ has a patented Guardian Required feature that helps ensure students are released only to authorized guardians and records the date, time, location and which guardian received the student.



# Emergency Request

If an emergency arises, a driver can tap on one of the several options on the Emergency Request screen.





# Evacuation and Reunification

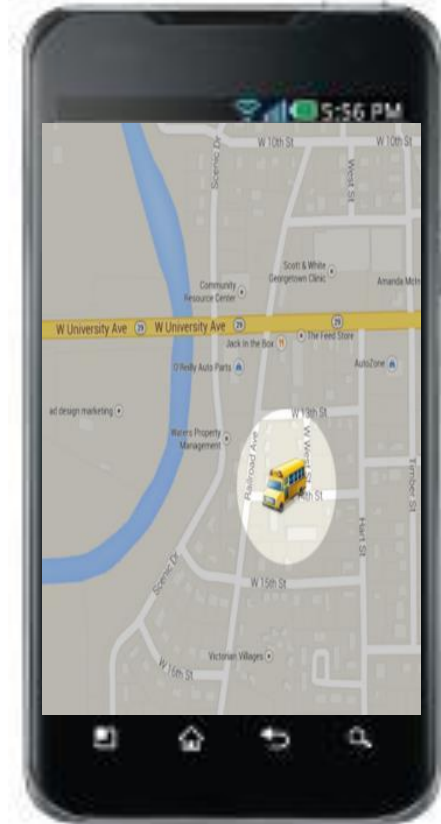
Getting students away from danger is the most important objective.

Knowing which students are on which buses for reunification is the second most important objective.





# SMART Alerts/Locate

SMART alerts are text messages that inform parents when the bus is approximately 10-15 minutes from their child's stop. SMART Locate is a feature that allows parents to see the location of the bus on its way to their child's stop and on to school.
