A Digital Path to Success




Students, kindergarten through twelfth grade, are using devices to create electronic portfolios of their work that can be viewed and shared online. Students use the eportfolios to present projects at venues like Techno Expo, the district's technology showcase, and Night of No Limits, the district's project based learning and science exhibit. As Northwest ISD prepares students with digital skills, critical thinking, communication, and collaboration, the eportfolios are examples of their work from elementary to high school and can be used upon graduation as they transition to a higher education.





V.R. Eaton High School is Northwest ISD's newest comprehensive high school and opened its doors in Fort Worth on Tuesday, August 25, 2015, welcoming approximately 1,000 freshman and sophomore students. Located in the



Willow Springs housing development and serving students from Fort Worth, Newark, and Haslet, Eaton High School is situated in one of the fastest growing areas in Northwest ISD. Eaton High School will add a grade level each year until it serves ninth through twelfth grade students in the 2017-2018 school year.

Eaton High School is home to the district's seventh career academy The Academy of Business Management and Entrepreneurship. This comprehensive four-year business high school program takes students out of the standard high school classroom and into an environment modeled after the corporate world. Prior to graduation, students will have operated their own business as well as a virtual business.

Thanks to a supportive community, NISD has been able to continue to build and prepare for the future. In 2012, voters approved a \$255 million bond referendum to provide for 4,000 additional new student seats, V.R. Eaton High School, a future middle school (opening in August 2019), and technology and building additions.
